RULES & REGULATIONS

Brookfield Academy H. S. School always gives emphasis on the disciplinary aspect for overall development of education. Discipline in any field always leads to progress as well as prosperity and for students it deserves an utmost importance. The Institution has set the following instructions for the students to abide by so that learning atmosphere could be maintained and the ultimate goal of quality education be achieved.

1. Students must maintain high degree of discipline. Any complaints in this respect will mean withdrawal from the institution without prior notice.
2. The institution does not permit the students to be late or irregular to institution.
3. Students should attend institution regularly & punctually in clean & tidy uniform. They should stay away from chewing tobacco, parag, smoking and taking alcohol and drugs. Such students will be immediately expelled from the institution and be disqualified to join institutions under Higher Secondary Education Board (HSEB)
4. Parents/guardians are not allowed to see/meet their children or interview any teacher during the institution hours. The teachers may only be interviewed with the permission of the office of the principal.
5. Any damage done to institution property should be repaired by the concerned student.
6. Books, periodicals or magazines of any objectionable nature should not be brought in the institution.
7. If a student discontinues for a month without any notice his/her name will be struck off from the register. In such a case request for re-admission can be granted at the cost of Rs.1000/- as re-admission.
8. Parents are reminded that all complaints and suggestions must be sent in print. Parents should notify the institution in writing the absence of the student(s).
9. The institution does not permit any student to wear jewellery and cosmetics, to have growing and colouring of nails and to bring cell phone and other electronic equipments.
10. If there are any complications or conflicts regarding the matter of teaching subject, teaching methodology, teaching facilities etc, students can submit the written application to the administration through class representative and students council.
11. If the students remain absent in internal exams without prior written application, Rs.100/- will be charged per subject.
12. Students should carry all the required teaching learning materials.
13. Once the name of a student is enrolled for institution transportation facility, he/she is not allowed to leave the bus as per his/her choice. The student who fails to register his/her name for the facility will be barred for using the facility.
14. Students are not allowed to go outside the institution premises during the institution hours.
15. Students are free to receive, return and study books in the library throughout the institution hours.
16. Students should hand over sport materials as well as other materials to the institution after the end of games or use.
17. The scholarship awarded to any student on the basis of SLC + Entrance performance will be for one academic year only. Further, the scholarships for Grade XII will be based on the performance of the student in Grade XI Board Exam.
18. The student who wants to transfer from the institution is bound to pay the full amount in admission and tuition fees of the whole academic year. *(This is applicable even to the students with all types of scholarship)*
19. Students must deposit the monthly tuition fee of the previous month before the 10th of the current month. If not, Rs.50 will be fined per month.
20. Admission fees/monthly fees once deposited cannot be withdrawn.
